The Oregon Travel Philanthropy Fund benefits:

Wallowa County Agritourism Development | Northeast Oregon Economic Development District | This program will help develop agritourism in Eastern Oregon by developing new marketing tools for local food products and services.

Building the Rogue River Corridor and Greenway | Rogue River Greenway Foundation | The corridor will connect the town of Rogue River to the Valley of the Rogue, providing a trail for children, families and travelers to recreate.

Promoting Locally Grown Beans & Grains | Willamette Farm & Food Coalition | The Coalition will develop new marketing tools to increase sales to local consumers of beans, grains and edible seeds grown by farms in the southern Willamette Valley.

Deschutes Restoration Outreach Program | Trout Unlimited | TU is implementing DROP in Central Oregon to restore and sustain the health of the upper Deschutes basin by increasing volunteer engagement and service in the region.

Mosier Plateau Trail Project | Friends of the Columbia Gorge | Friends is partnering with the Mosier community and a private landowner to build a sustainable, multi-use trail, the first in Friends' Gorge Towns to Trails Campaign.

Sustainable Seafood Initiative | Friends of Haystack Rock | The Initiative will expand the Haystack Rock Awareness Program's concerning sustainable seafood choices and encourage patronage of local program partners.

The Living Highways Project | Friends of Trees | Friends of Trees will plant and maintain over 5,000 trees along the I-205 multi-use transportation corridor with the help of 2,000 volunteers as part of the I-205 Greenspace Initiative.

Travel Philanthropy funds will be collected by Sustainable Travel International from participating businesses across the state. Funds will be distributed equally amongst all seven projects.
