



WildSpring Covid-19 Procedures

So you will understand how we are working to limit exposure for guests and staff to Covid-19:

Two of our five cabins are closed down to limit the number of people here.

Our staff is instructed to leave 6' of distance between themselves and guests.

The spa's water is kept at a level of bromine (as effective as chlorine, but much easier on skin and hair) that kills viruses and bacteria.

When a staff member first enters a cabin or Guest Hall, they wash their hands with hot soapy water for 20 seconds.

During each cabin preparation, freshen and clean, we disinfect doorknobs, light switches, any push buttons, TV remote, faucet handles and appropriate surfaces with chlorine wipes.

When a guest checks out, first we ozonate the cabin before going in to clean, which has been proven to kill the SARS coronavirus...which indicates it will also kill the covid-19 coronavirus.

We repeatedly disinfect doorknobs, light switches and appropriate surfaces in the Guest Hall during the day with chlorine wipes.

We have a bottle of hand sanitizer on the Guest Hall butcher block with a note asking all guests to use it as soon as they enter.
