



## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFO

- Please use hand sanitizer before entering the Guest Hall (there is a silver dispenser on the door jam) and unvaccinated guests must wear a face mask in the Guest Hall (except while you're eating...).
- Your cabin will only be freshened at your request (before 3pm) and we will ask for a time when you will be out of your cabin.
- Hour-long appointments for the hot tub are available for 1 cabin at a time from 9am to 8pm.

Guests may use the hot tub from 8 to 11pm without restriction **(please call us on the cabin intercom when you're heading up so we can make sure it's ready for you).**



## **WildSpring Covid-19 Safety Procedures**

*We are working to limit exposure for guests and staff to possible Covid-19:*

Our staff is vaccinated and instructed to leave at least 6' of distance between themselves and guests. We ask guests to respect distance as well.

### Guest Hall:

There is a silver dispenser of hand sanitizer at the entrance to the Guest Hall. Staff is instructed to use this before entering. We ask guests to do this, too.

We have a surgical-grade air purifier running in the Guest Hall at all times. We repeatedly disinfect doorknobs, light switches and appropriate items and surfaces during the day.

### Cabins:

When a guest checks out, first we use a UV tower to kill any airborne virus in the cabin before going in to disinfect the surfaces, including doorknobs, keyless doorlock, light switches, any push buttons, TV remote and all appropriate items and surfaces.

Your cabin will only be freshened at your request and we will ask for a time when you will be out of your cabin, but before 3pm (we will not touch any of your things). Or, let us know if you need something, we can drop it off on your porch.

### Hot Tub:

The Hot Tub is available from 9am to 11pm from Memorial Day weekend through Sept, and from 3 to 10pm the rest of the year. Guests can make appointments for one cabin at a time until 8pm (starting at the top of the hour), after 8pm guests who are vaccinated may use the open-air hot tub without restriction. Contact the office for availability and scheduling.

The spa's water is kept at a level of bromine (as effective as chlorine, but much easier on skin and hair) that kills viruses and bacteria.
